Conditions:	<p>➤ There are three (3) Age Categories: 10-14 yrs., 15-20 yrs., 21 yrs. and older.</p> <p>➤ Participants are invited to write in one of the following genres: fiction, non-fiction, poetry, spoken word, song or short play.</p> <p>➤ For Song Writing, all contestants are to work from home or another space of their choosing. They will be emailed the subject matter at the appointed time. It is expect the music will have been conceived of prior and the writing on the day is the lyrics and putting it together with the music.</p> <p>➤ When the competition starts, each different writing genre group is given a theme on which to write ie: Water or Courage or Survival etc..../these amazing examples are now out of the running :- (</p> <p>➤ Writers can be solo, duos or groups (each person must register and pay the \$25)</p> <p>➤ At the end of the 150 minutes, the judges read the works and deliberate. During this time, the spoken word and songs will be performed in front of judges. After which, writers will read from their works. The public is invited to attend this portion, as well as the announcement of the winners.</p> <p>➤ The 1st place, 2nd place and 3rd place winners will be published in a book by local publisher Pre-Raphaelite Brotherhood Publishing, which will include a download link to the Spoken Word and Song winners.</p> <p>➤ The cost to enter: 25\$, which includes light snacks, water, coffee and tea (other drinks not included).</p> <p>➤ Published works remain the property of the author and NOT the property of the organizers or publisher.</p> <p>➤ There is a maximum number of 10 participant spots for each genre in each age category.</p> <p>MUST READ BEFORE REGISTERING</p> <p><i>Please note: Each age category within each genre must have 2 writers competing, if not we will cancel that category and refund your money.</i></p>		

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Rules:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ The word count limit must not exceed 1000 words maximum (but can be less). ➤ All Fiction, Non-Fiction, Poetry, Short Play and Spoken Word contestants must bring their paper and pen/pencil or fully charged laptop and a set of ear plugs. ➤ Writers have 150 minutes (2 1/2 hours) to write. ➤ Writing commences at the beginning of the competition once you receive knowledge of the genre topic from the Writing in 150 organizers. ➤ All writing must be done on the premise of the Writing in 150 writing competition location (except for Song writing). ➤ The subject matter of the work must focus on the theme provided by the Writing in 150 organizers to the writers in groups based on writing genre. This means the work must be about the theme provided and cannot just mention the theme concept in the text, but rather the text must explore the concept. ➤ Anyone found to be disrupting the other writers will be requested to leave without reimbursement (basically all participants must be respectful to others during this event). ➤ Writers must email their finished text to the Writing in 150 organizers before 1:30 pm on the day of the competition. Texts must be sent to abunchofpeopleartsandevents@gmail.com ➤ The deadline to register and complete the payment is by 5:00 pm EST on March 26th, 2020 (for mailing, the envelope must be stamp on this day). ➤ By signing this form you agree to have your work published in the book of winners resulting from the Writing in 150 (2020) Writing competition. ➤ The organizers have a right to move the location of the event, if deemed necessary.
